No, though they have Ardsley postal addresses, and served by the Ardsley Fire Department, they are located squarely in unincorporated Town of Greenburgh

Louis Pascone Memorial Park is the new name for Ashford Park

**No, though it has an Ardsley mailing
address, it is entirely in unincorporated
Town of Greenburgh**

Isn't Lawrence Street in Ardsley?

**No, it is located entirely in
unincorporated Town of Greenburgh**

**Isn't Anthony Veteran Town Park
located in Ardsley?**

**Yes and no. Although it has an Ardsley
mailing address, it overlaps both Ardsley
and unincorporated Greenburgh Town.**

**The undeveloped four acres abutting
Heatherdell Road are physically in the
Village.**

**Isn't the Ardsley Country Club in
Ardsley?**

No. The Ardsley Country Club actually straddles the Dobbs Ferry / Irvington border, and is no where near Ardsley.

Isn't Ardsley-on-Hudson part of the Village?

Despite what the MetroNorth timetable may attempt to make you believe, there is no Ardsley train station. The stop referenced on the schedule has to do with a small neighborhood in Irvington just due north and behind Mercy College

Where is Ardsley Square?

Despite what the BeeLine bus schedule says, there is no Ardsley Square. What they are referring to is actually Addyman Square. Efforts to correct this with the County over the years have proven fruitless
