Mr. McGarvey stated that the trees have been flagged and that he had spoken with the next-door neighbor who, along with the Planning Board, expressed concern about runoff into the pond. Mr. McGarvey stated that the plans now show a second row of silt fencing around the pond, and an orange construction fence around that, in effect double protection and a warning fence. Mr. McGarvey reported that the fifteen trees which he originally thought needed to be removed, has been reduced to seven; and further than they will try to save trees in the sewer easement area if Westchester County agrees to the one-and-a-half-inch main; and that when the sewer trench is refilled, they will plant grass seed and native plant seed. Mr. McGarvey further reported that they are proposing to plant fourteen new trees, four on the tree line and ten along the easement line.

Mr. Greechan reported that the items noted in his memo and discussed by the Board had all been addressed and only the inverts need to be clarified. Mr. Greechan noted that the sewer line is deemed a pressure line, and that the Village will take over only the gravity portion of the sewer line.

The Chair asked if any member of the public wished to speak on this matter, but no member of the public was present.

The Chair moved, and Mr. Preisser seconded, to close the Public Hearing.

Mr. Senor stated that they had proposed the sewer go out to the South, but noted that there is a gravity connection to the North, and that a ten-foot separation to the water line is needed.

Mr. Senor advised that there are six trees that are coming down. The Chair stated that the trees need to be flagged, and Mr. Senor said that they could tag them within the next few days. Ms. Jainchill expressed concern about the huge tulip tree.

Mr. Senor advised that they had received Mr. Greechan's memorandum, showing a oneeighth inch difference in rainfall, which would require 5.8 capture and they have provided for 6.0.

Mr. Greechan advised getting a determination from the Health Department, as the sewer is in a public right of way. The Chair suggested that applicant consider going the other way, and asked that they follow up with Mr. Greechan.

The Chair asked if any member of the public wished to speak in favor of or in opposition to the application.

Mr. Frank Liu stated that after a light rain there is ponding on his property. Mr. Liu also would like there to be fencing for the safety of children. The Chair stated that the Planning Board will consider requiring a swale, but expects that the grading and drainage work should ameliorate the problem; Mr. Greechan will review.

The Chair advised that this Public Hearing will be continued.
