

VILLAGE OF ARDSLEY CAMPAIGN SIGN POLICY

Please find reproduced below the Village of Ardsley's campaign sign and poster policy in place since February 1983 and honored by all political parties:

"In view of the coming election, all candidates are herewith apprised of the policy of the Village in regard to the placement of campaign signs and posters within the Village limits. The following regulations should be adhered to:

1. No posters or signs may be placed on utility poles.
2. The erection of any sign must be cleared through and approved by the Village Manager's office.
3. The location of all campaign signs must be limited to the areas specified herein for that purpose. These are:
 - a. The triangular parcel (privately owned) at the intersection of Saw Mill River Road and Heatherdell Road. [The approval for the erection of the sign must also be obtained from the owner, John Bobolakis, of Scarsdale who has an unlisted phone number. I will share that number with you if you need it.]
 - b. At the northern extremity of Ardsley along Saw Mill River Road in the right of way adjacent to the Rite Aid Pharmacy shopping area also known as the Towne Plaza.
 - c. At the southern extremity of Ardsley along Saw Mill River Road in the right of way, near Colony Street.
 - d. At the eastern end of Heatherdell Road in the right of way across the road from McDowell Park.
 - e. At the eastern end of Ashford Avenue, in the right of way across the road from Ashford Park on opposite sides of the bus shelter.
4. Signs shall be erected in such a way that the signs do not constitute any hazard to vehicular or pedestrian traffic.
5. The Chief of Police shall be notified of the proposed location of all such signs so that he can ensure that the line of sight for vehicles and pedestrians is not interfered with. [The Village Manager will carbon copy your written request to the Chief.]
6. Signs shall be limited to a size not greater than 4' x 4'.
7. Signs shall be removed within 24 hours of the election day by the candidate or the Committee.

8. A confirming letter from the candidate or the Committee enumerating the locations and the dates during which the signs will be displayed and the date of removal shall be delivered to the Village office prior to the erection of the signs."
