Re: **KING STREET BRIDGE CULVERT REPLACEMENT PROJECT – Letter #2**

Dear King Street Resident:

The pre-construction meeting for the King Street culvert project was held on Friday, September 6 with our consulting engineer from Woodard & Curran, the contractor, Tardio Landscaping, the Highway Foreman, and the Village Manager. No firm date has yet been set for the actual construction work pending filing of all the requisite paperwork. However, the contractor is still looking at the first week of October.

We learned late Monday afternoon that Con Edison has filed its paperwork and will be performing some gas line relocation work later this week. King Street will remain open to pedestrian and motorist traffic during this preliminary work, and flagmen will be present.

With regard to the actual construction work when the road will be blocked with construction equipment, I am pleased to advise that OLPH has graciously agreed to allow King Street residents to park in their parking lot. This accommodation is in addition to having parking available at Village Hall and the Library parking lots. The contractor has also assured us that he will make a special accommodation during the construction period for the resident in daily need of ParaTransit service. Though residents may see some equipment stored on the sides of the road, the main staging area for supplies and equipment will be in Pascone Park at a location designated by our Highway Foreman. I don't yet have the exact start and end times of construction work Monday through Friday but it's looking like 8:00 am to 6:00 pm. However, I do know the road will be open at the end of each work day, and there will be no work on Saturdays and Sundays. The actual dates of construction and work schedule will be distributed in a third letter once confirmed.

As I stated in my letter of August 9, we wish to ensure that everyone affected by this construction receives regular notices, so if you are the Landlord of one of the properties with accessory apartments kindly either advise your tenants or provide them with copies of this letter. Thank you for your cooperation with this matter. During the construction do not hesitate to ask questions of the on site Foreman Joe Tardio.
