Re: **KING STREET BRIDGE CULVERT REPLACEMENT PROJECT – Letter #3**

Dear King Street Resident:

As you may have noticed some preliminary work has commenced on King Street. Con Edison's relocation of the gas line officially starts on Wednesday, October 2., and should be completed by Friday, October 14. The relocation of the water lines by United Water commences shortly thereafter. Once completed, Tardio Landscaping will commence their work on the bridge. The work conducted by Con Edison and United Water will not require the closure of the road. However, there will be from time to time brief closures to move equipment. During those times, flag men will be on hand to direct traffic. Unfortunately, there is just no way to predict when those temporary closures will take place.

With regard to the actual construction work, performed by Tardio Landscaping, when the road will be blocked with construction equipment, I am pleased to remind you that OLPH has graciously agreed to allow King Street residents to park in their parking lot. This accommodation is in addition to having parking available at Village Hall and the Library parking lots. The contractor has also assured us that he will make a special accommodation during the construction period for the resident in daily need of ParaTransit service. Though residents may see some equipment stored on the sides of the road, the main staging area for supplies and equipment will be in Pascone Park at a location designated by our Highway Foreman. The start and end times of construction work are expected to be Monday through Friday from 8:00 am to 6:00 pm. King Street will be open at the end of each work day, and there will be no work on Saturdays and Sundays.

To assist with the possibility of a fire during the road closure, the Ardsley Fire Department will be locating fire fighting equipment in the cul de sac at the north end of the road. ASVAC has also assured us they will be able to manage emergencies as they may arise.

As I stated in my letter of August 9, we wish to ensure that everyone affected by this construction receives regular notices, so if you are the Landlord of one of the properties with accessory apartments kindly either advise your tenants or provide them with copies of this letter. Thank you for your cooperation with this matter. During the construction do not hesitate to ask questions of the on site Foreman Joe Tardio.
