

VILLAGE ABOLISHES ASSESSMENT UNIT STATUS

Please be advised that at a public hearing held on Monday, October 3, 2011 the Village Board of the Village of Ardsley abolished its status as an assessment unit.

What does this mean?

- All assessment functions have been transferred to the Town of Greenburgh.
- The position of Village Assessor has been abolished. All duties have been transferred to the Town Assessor, Edye McCarthy.
- The Ardsley Village Board no longer will act as the Board of Assessment Review. All of its functions have been transferred to the Greenburgh Board of Assessment Review.
- Grievances and SCAR petitions will no longer be filed with the Village. Such grievances must now be filed with the Town of Greenburgh.
- There will no longer be an annual Grievance night in February in Ardsley. All Grievances must be filed with the Town of Greenburgh for their annual Grievance night in June.
- Successful petitions for assessment reductions with the Town in June will apply to Village assessments as well without having to file a second petition, as in the past.
- All exemptions whether they be Veteran, Aged, Disabled, Volunteer Fire, Volunteer Ambulance, must be filed with the Town Greenburgh Assessor's office.
- The general telephone phone number of the Town Assessor's Office is 993-1520. All filing deadlines must be confirmed with the Town Assessor's Office.
