The Chair stated that the Board had received the proposed landscape plan and finds it insufficient. The Chair advised that Board member Ms. Jainchill, a landscape architect, would like applicant to provide a plan drawn by a landscape architect or natural resource professional, and that such a plan should show the quantity, location and species of what is to be planted. Mr. Preisser explained that applicant's present plan stating, for example, "evergreen trees as needed" does not provide enough information.

Mr. Bialowas asked if the present landscape plan is different than the last plan submitted, and Mr. Markushi replied that it is. Mr. Bialowas explained that the Board's concerns would protect the stream in the future. Mr. Bialowas suggested, as an aside, that the new deck is very exposed on the corner and that Mr. Markush might enjoy greater privacy if he planted a large tree or added a taller railing.

The Chair stated that the Planning Board adopts Ms. Jainchill's comments on the plan and will send those comments to Mr. Tomasso, who will forward them to applicant.
