RESOLUTION SCHEDULING A PUBLIC HEARING TAX OVERRIDE

PLEASE TAKE NOTICE that the Board of Trustees of the Village of Ardsley will hold a public hearing at 8:15 p.m., Tuesday, February 18, 2020, in the Municipal Building Boardroom, 507 Ashford Avenue, Ardsley, New York, to consider a resolution to override the property tax levy for fiscal year 2020-2021.

Section 1. Legislative Intent

It is the intent of this local law to allow the Village of Ardsley to adopt a budget for the fiscal year commencing June 1, 2019 that requires a real property tax levy in excess of the "tax levy limit" as defined by General Municipal Law § 3-c.

Section 2. Authority

This local law is adopted pursuant to subdivision 5 of General Municipal Law §3-c, which expressly authorizes a local government's governing body to override the property tax cap for the coming fiscal year by the adoption of a local law approved by a vote of sixty percent (60%) of said governing body.

Section 3. Tax Levy Limit Override

The Village Board of Trustees of the Village of Ardsley, County of Westchester, is hereby authorized to adopt a budget for the fiscal year commencing June 1, 2019 that requires a real property tax levy in excess of the amount otherwise prescribed in General Municipal Law §3-c.

Section 4. Severability

If a court determines that any clause, sentence, paragraph, subdivision, or part of this local law or the application thereof to any person, firm or corporation, or circumstance is invalid or unconstitutional, the court's order or judgment shall not affect, impair, or invalidate the remainder of this local law, but shall be confined in its operation to the clause, sentence, paragraph, subdivision, or part of this local law or in its application to the person, individual, firm or corporation or circumstance, directly involved in the controversy in which such judgment or order shall be rendered.

Section 5. Effective date

This local law shall take effect immediately upon filing with the Secretary of State by the Village Clerk.



RESOLUTION REGARDING OVERRIDE TO PROPERTY TAX LEVY 2020-2021

RESOLVED, that the Village Board of the Village of Ardsley hereby enacts a local law establishing a property tax levy in excess of the limit established in General Municipal Law Section 3-c as follows:

Section 1. Legislative Intent

It is the intent of this local law to allow the Village of Ardsley to adopt a budget for the fiscal year commencing June 1, 2020 that requires a real property tax levy in excess of the "tax levy limit" as defined by General Municipal Law § 3-c.

Section 2. Authority

This local law is adopted pursuant to subdivision 5 of General Municipal Law §3-c, which expressly authorizes a local government's governing body to override the property tax cap for the coming fiscal year by the adoption of a local law approved by a vote of sixty percent (60%) of said governing body.

Section 3. Tax Levy Limit Override

The Village Board of Trustees of the Village of Ardsley, County of Westchester, is hereby authorized to adopt a budget for the fiscal year commencing June 1, 2020 that requires a real property tax levy in excess of the amount otherwise prescribed in General Municipal Law §3-c.

Section 4. Severability

If a court determines that any clause, sentence, paragraph, subdivision, or part of this local law or the application thereof to any person, firm or corporation, or circumstance is invalid or unconstitutional, the court's order or judgment shall not affect, impair, or invalidate the remainder of this local law, but shall be confined in its operation to the clause, sentence, paragraph, subdivision, or part of this local law or in its application to the person, individual, firm or corporation or circumstance, directly involved in the controversy in which such judgment or order shall be rendered.

Section 5. Effective date

This local law shall take effect immediately upon filing with the Secretary of State by the Village Clerk.

A LOCAL LAW AMENDING CHAPTER 165 OF THE CODE OF THE VILLAGE OF ARDSLEY

The owner of all premises using the Village of Ardsley sewer system or any part thereof shall be required to pay sewer rents for the payment of the costs of operation, maintenance and repairs of the Village of Ardsley sewer system.

B. Applicability.

The sewer system for which the sewer rents are established and imposed is the entire sewer system within the Village of Ardsley as defined in section 451 of the General Municipal Law as it does now or as it may from time to time exist.

C. Setting of rates.

All sewer rent rates, charges, fees and penalties, shall be established by the Village Board of Trustees by resolution, shall be based upon the consumption of water on the premises connected with and served by the sewer system and shall be set forth in the Fee Schedule maintained by the office of the Village Clerk.

D. Payments.

Sewer rents shall be payable on the schedule set by the Village Board of Trustees.

E. Billing.

The Village is authorized to obtain the services of a third-party billing company to generate and send out all Sewer rent bills. Such third-party billing company shall be hired by the Village pursuant to a New York State Public Service Commission approved water usage agreement. Such third-party billing company shall send such bills to the address of the property owner on the assessment rolls and such bills shall be sent on the frequency set the by the Village Board but delivery of such bills to the proper party is not guaranteed. If the consumer does not receive a bill on or before the fifth day following the period, he or she should call the Third-Party billing company designated by the Village.

Sewer rent bills shall be issued on the basis set forth by the Village Board of Trustees.

F. Late Payment penalties, liens and collection.

All bills for sewer rents are due and payable at the address given on the bill and the time set forth by the Village Board of Trustees. All amounts due for sewer rents will be received without penalty during the first month following the billing. Penalty shall be charged at a rate set forth by the Village Board of Trustees on all bills that remain unpaid past thirty days from the date of billing. Such penalties will be added to the bill, in accordance with the provisions of the Village Law. The Third party billing company shall send to the Village Treasurer all delinquent accounts which in accordance with General Municipal Law section 452 the delinquent sewer rents shall constitute a lien upon the real property served by the sewer system. The lien shall be prior and superior to every other lien or claim except the lien of an existing tax, assessment or other lawful charge imposed by or for the state or a political subdivision or district thereof. Delinquent accounts, including sewer rents and penalties shall be collected in a manner provided in General Municipal Law§452(4)

G. Sewer Rent Fund.

All revenues derived from sewer rents, including penalties, shall be credited by the Treasurer to a special fund to be known as the "Sewer Rent Fund." Monies in such fund shall be used in accordance with section 53 of the General Municipal Law.

H. This local law shall take effect immediately upon filing with the Secretary of State of the State of New York.
