### **3. DEPARTMENT REPORTS**

#### **1. LEGAL**

- 1.a Village Attorney, Robert Ponzini stated he had nothing to report other than those items that may have been submitted in memorandum form and would be available for Executive Session after the meeting if needed.

Trustee Weitz questioned memorandum form and would like a legal update.

Village Attorney Robert Ponzini stated that he issues a memo on topics that requires a memo such as certiorari claims.

Village Manager Cerretani explained that many of the legal updates are not up for discussion in a public forum.

#### **2. MANAGER**

- 2.a Village Manager Joseph Cerretani read the following report:

1. **POLICE ACCREDITATION:** I unfortunately was unable to make the last Legislative Meeting of the Village Board, but I did want to express my sincere congratulations to Chief Piccolino and the Ardsley Police Department for being recommended for accreditation. I had the privilege of meeting with the assessors from the Division of Criminal Justice Services throughout their few days here in the Village and going through a detailed debriefing session where they were able to articulate their findings. I was very impressed with both the depth of detail that the assessors demanded as part of their inspection, and the immediate and flawless response given by the members of the Police Department. Throughout the debriefing, the assessors had made numerous comments about the level of preparation by the entire department. Another comment that was made is that the auditors were almost equally as impressed with the inter and intra departmental communication and teamwork that they observed and how unusual it is to see that in a local government. I am very proud of Chief Piccolino and the entire police department on their

performance and would like to congratulate them on their recommendation for becoming an accredited agency.

2. **SANITARY/STORM SEWER MAPPING PROJECT:** Fred Cook is continuing to perform the closed camera television recording work. So far there is nothing major to report, which is good news. Due to holidays and potential weather delays, we anticipate this phase of the project being complete by the end of the month.
3. **NEW DPW CONSTRUCTION PROJECT:** The project is continuing to make progress through the winter. We are out on the site this afternoon. The steel rebar for the footings has been installed and the crew began their first concrete pour today for the footings located along the rear of the future buildings. Contractors will try to capitalize on the current weather conditions and continue as long as conditions allow.
4. **SCHOOL CROSSING GUARDS:** We have advertised for a second crossing guard position to assist with pedestrian safety. Chief Piccolino is reviewing applications and scheduling interviews. We hope to have an appointment made in the next two weeks.
5. **HOLIDAY SCHEDULE:** All Village Offices, including the Justice Court, the Library, the Community Center, and the Department of Public Works will be closed on Monday, January 16, 2023 in observance of Martin Luther King Jr. Day. There will be no refuse collection that day. There WILL BE refuse collection for the entire village on Tuesday, January 17, 2023.

## Curbing project

Curb work has been completed for 2022, and will resume again in the spring. One side of Lincoln Avenue and small section of Taft Lane was completed to date. Work will resume in the spring on the remaining streets and full restoration to follow.

## Sewer Line cleaning/camera work

Contractor is approximately 80% done with jetting and camera work. No major issues have been discovered. We have identified many buried manholes, which public works will start uncover raise to grade.

## New Sewer Jet Truck

New sewer truck has been delivered and Highway personnel has been trained on operating and maintaining the new truck.

## New Highway Garage

Site work continues with the good weather we have been having. Foundations for the new building is being installed. Building has been ordered and will be delivered by the end of April or beginning of May 2023. I have been involved daily with all aspects of the construction and happy to report that work is on schedule to date. We have incurred some delays on materials, but it seems to be getting better monthly.

## Other Items

- Public works has been clearing and grubbing main entrances to Village at Ashford Ave. and Heatherdell Rd. from Greenburgh side. Come Spring we would like to plant trees/shrubs/grass at these locations.
- Street sign replacement is ongoing though out the Village. We are approximately 70% completed with this project.
- The new e-waste/metal scheduling calendar has been getting a better response and many residents are starting to use it.

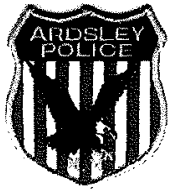



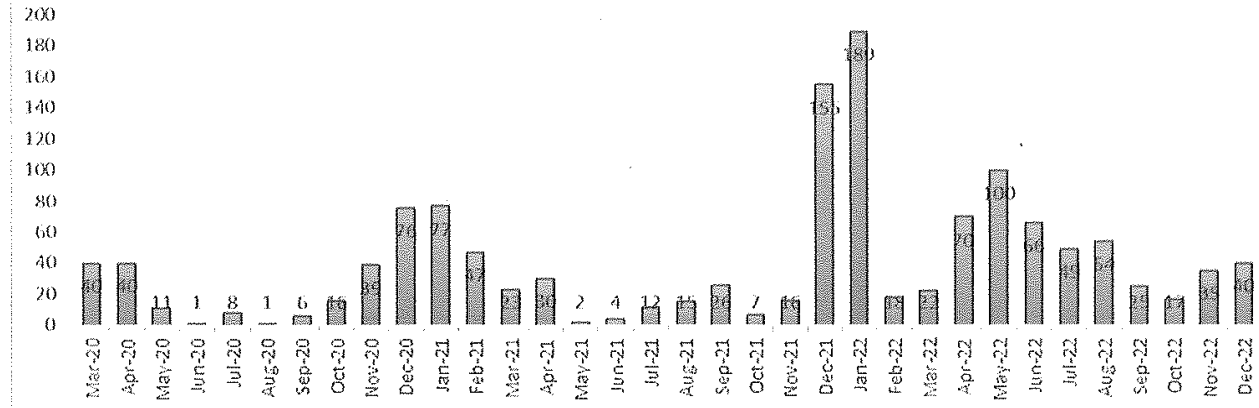

## CDC streamlines COVID-19 guidance to help the public better protect themselves and understand their risk

Today, CDC is streamlining its COVID-19 guidance to help people better understand their risk, how to protect themselves and others, what actions to take if exposed to COVID-19, and what actions to take if they are sick or test positive for the virus. COVID-19 continues to circulate globally, however, with so many tools available to us for reducing COVID-19 severity, there is significantly less risk of severe illness, hospitalization and death compared to earlier in the pandemic.

"We're in a stronger place today as a nation, with more tools—like vaccination, boosters, and treatments—to protect ourselves, and our communities, from severe illness from COVID-19," said Greta Massetti, PhD, MPH, MMWR author. "We also have a better understanding of how to protect people from being exposed to the virus, like wearing high-quality masks, testing, and improved ventilation. This guidance acknowledges that the pandemic is not over, but also helps us move to a point where COVID-19 no longer severely disrupts our daily lives."

In support of this update CDC is:

- Continuing to promote the importance of being up to date with vaccination to protect people against serious illness, hospitalization, and death. Protection provided by the current vaccine against symptomatic infection and transmission is less than that against severe disease and diminishes over time, especially against the currently circulating

variants. For this reason, it is important to stay up to date, especially as new vaccines become available.

- Updating its guidance for people who are not up to date on COVID-19 vaccines on what to do if exposed to someone with COVID-19. This is consistent with the existing guidance for people who are up to date on COVID-19 vaccines.
- Recommending that instead of quarantining if you were exposed to COVID-19, you wear a high-quality mask for 10 days and get tested on day 5.
- Reiterating that regardless of vaccination status, you should isolate from others when you have COVID-19.
  - You should also isolate if you are sick and suspect that you have COVID-19 but do not yet have test results.
    - If your results are positive, follow CDC's full isolation recommendations.
    - If your results are negative, you can end your isolation.
- Recommending that if you test positive for COVID-19, you stay home for at least 5 days and isolate from others in your home. You are likely most infectious during these first 5 days. Wear a high-quality mask when you must be around others at home and in public.
  - If after 5 days you are fever-free for 24 hours without the use of medication, and your symptoms are improving, or you never had symptoms, you may end isolation after day 5.
  - Regardless of when you end isolation, avoid being around people who are more likely to get very sick from COVID-19 until at least day 11.
  - You should wear a high-quality mask through day 10.
- Recommending that if you had moderate illness (if you experienced shortness of breath or had difficulty breathing) or severe illness (you were hospitalized) due to COVID-19 or you have a weakened immune system, you need to isolate through day 10.
- Recommending that if you had severe illness or have a weakened immune system, consult your doctor before ending isolation. Ending isolation without a viral test may not be an option for you. If you are unsure if your symptoms are moderate or severe or if you have a weakened immune system, talk to a healthcare provider for further guidance.
- Clarifying that after you have ended isolation, if your COVID-19 symptoms worsen, restart your isolation at day 0. Talk to a healthcare provider if you have questions about your symptoms or when to end isolation.
- Recommending screening testing of asymptomatic people without known exposures will no longer be recommended in most community settings.



- Emphasizing that physical distance is just one component of how to protect yourself and others. It is important to consider the risk in a particular setting, including local COVID-19 Community Levels and the important role of ventilation, when assessing the need to maintain physical distance.

Actions to take will continue to be informed by the [COVID-19 Community Levels](#), launched in February. CDC will continue to focus efforts on preventing severe illness and post-COVID conditions, while ensuring everyone have the information and tools, they need to lower their risk.

This updated guidance is intended to apply to community settings. In the coming weeks CDC will work to align stand-alone guidance documents, such as those for healthcare settings, congregate settings at higher risk of transmission, and travel, with today's update.

**RESOLVED**, that the Village Board of the Village of Ardsley hereby promotes Sergeant Daniel Watson to the position of Lieutenant, at the annual salary of \$156,627.00, effective February 1, 2023;

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED**, that in accordance with the civil service rules of the Westchester County Department of Human Resources such appointment is subject to a probationary period of not less than 12 and not more than 52 weeks.

**RESOLUTION TO AUTHORIZE THE VILLAGE MAYOR TO SIGN A  
STIPULATION OF AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE VILLAGE OF  
ARDSLEY AND POLICE BENEVOLENT ASSOCIATION**

**WHEREAS**, the Village of Ardsley (“Village”) and Ardsley Policemen’s Benevolent Association, Inc. (“PBA”) are parties to a collective bargaining agreement for the period June 1, 2019 – May 31, 2021 (“CBA”); and

**WHEREAS**, the Village and PBA have held additional discussions and arrived at a new Stipulation of Agreement (“Stipulation”) dated January 13, 2023, which modifies the CBA to provide a health insurance buyout payment for eligible bargaining unit retirees, and which further modifies the CBA’s health insurance buyout payment schedule for eligible active bargaining unit members and eligible retirees.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that the Village Board of Trustees hereby approves and ratifies the attached Stipulation as executed by the Village and PBA, including all terms set forth therein.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that the Village Mayor is hereby authorized to execute a future collective bargaining agreement consistent with the terms of the CBA and the Stipulation when such document has been prepared and finalized.

### STIPULATION OF AGREEMENT

This Stipulation of Agreement ("Stipulation") is entered into this \_\_\_\_ day of January, 2023, by and between the Ardsley Policemen's Benevolent Association, Inc. ("PBA") and the Village of Ardsley ("Village").

WHEREAS, the District and PBA are parties to a Collective Bargaining Agreement for the period June 1, 2019 through May 31, 2021 ("CBA"); and

WHEREAS, Sergeant David Fisher ("Sergeant Fisher") is employed by the Village in its Police Department and, as a PBA bargaining unit member, is subject to the terms and conditions of employment set forth in the CBA; and

WHEREAS, Sergeant Fisher, as an active full-time employee, has been voluntarily opting out of health insurance coverage through the Village and, alternatively, receiving the health insurance buyout set forth in Article 10, Section 4 of the CBA; and

WHEREAS, Sergeant Fisher has indicated to the Village that he is retiring from the Village at the end of January, 2023; and

WHEREAS, questions and issues have arisen regarding the applicability of the health insurance buyout to retirees from the Village who are otherwise eligible for retiree health insurance through the Village under the CBA and the Village's plan (currently the New York State Health Insurance Plan's Empire Plan ("Empire Plan")); and

WHEREAS, the Village and PBA have engaged in discussions aimed at reaching mutually beneficial solutions to these questions and issues regarding the applicability of the health insurance buyout to retirees from the Village; and

WHEREAS, to avoid the time, expense, and risk of litigation, to continue fiscally responsible practices, and to maintain harmonious labor relations, the Village and PBA hereby acknowledge and agree as follows:

1. Notwithstanding the definition of "employee" set forth in Article I, Section 1 of the CBA, the Village and PBA agree that, effective January 1, 2023, "employee" as used only in Article 10, Section 4 (Health Insurance Buyout) of the CBA, and not as used in any other Article and/or Section of the CBA, shall be defined to include retirees from the Village, provided and expressly conditioned upon, that they were hired by the Village *prior to May 31, 2019* and that they are otherwise eligible to receive health insurance coverage in retirement pursuant to all remaining provisions of the CBA and Empire Plan.

Thus, effective January 1, 2023, employees who were hired by the Village *prior to May 31, 2019*, and who retire from the Village, and who are otherwise eligible to receive health insurance coverage in retirement pursuant to all remaining provisions of the CBA and Empire Plan, shall be entitled to receive the health insurance buyout, currently \$5,000.00 annually, set forth in Article 10, Section 4 of the CBA.

2. Effective March 1, 2023, the first sentence of the second paragraph in Article 10, Section 4 (Health Insurance Buyout) shall be changed to state as follows: "An employee who declines and waives family health insurance coverage as provided above, shall be paid five thousand dollars (\$5,000.00) annually, to be paid in equal amounts on the first (1<sup>st</sup>) pay period following each fiscal quarter." The Village and PBA shall make this change in any successor collective bargaining agreement between the parties.

The Village and PBA agree that the health insurance buyout payments (for both active employees and eligible retirees (pursuant to Paragraph 1 of this Stipulation)) shall be made in the first pay period following the fiscal quarter in which an employee or retiree has remained without health insurance coverage through the Village. For example, an employee or retiree who remains without health insurance coverage through the Village for the fiscal 4<sup>th</sup> quarter – March 1, 2023 through May 31, 2023 – shall be paid the equal quarterly amount for that fiscal 4<sup>th</sup> quarter in the first pay period in June 2023.

3. The Village and PBA agree that, except as set forth above in Paragraphs 1 and 2, the remaining provisions of Article 10, Section 4 of the CBA shall remain in full force and effect.

4. The PBA expressly waives and releases any and all claims, including grievances and arbitrations, regarding applicability of the CBA's health insurance buyout provisions to past, present or future retirees, and the timing and delivery of health insurance buyout payments to active employees or retirees that accrued and exist, or may have accrued and existed, as of the date of this Stipulation.

5. The Village does not admit, by the execution of this Stipulation, any fault, liability or wrongdoing whatsoever with regard to the facts and circumstances giving rise to the instant issues. This Stipulation is freely entered into solely to avoid the time, expense, and risk of litigation, and to continue fiscally responsible practices, and to maintain harmonious labor relations.

6. Except as specifically provided herein, including Paragraph 1 above, neither this Stipulation, nor its terms, shall constitute a practice or precedent, or evidence thereof, with respect to the Village's treatment of PBA members or retirees.

7. The Village and PBA agree that they each understand the full content, meaning, and import of this Stipulation; that they have had adequate time to review all terms of this Stipulation with counsel; and that they have all been satisfactorily represented by counsel in this matter.

8. This Stipulation may not be altered except by a writing signed by the Village and PBA and ratified by the Village Board of Trustees. This Stipulation may not be changed orally.

9. The language of all parts of this Stipulation shall be construed as a whole, according to its fair meaning, and not strictly for or against any party, regardless of by whom it was drafted.

10. This Stipulation represents the entire agreement between the Village and PBA, and supersedes any prior written or oral statements, agreements, memoranda, correspondence, conversations, discussions and/or negotiations held, or which have taken place, among the Village and PBA and/or their attorneys, agents or representatives, with respect to matters covered by this Stipulation.


11. This Stipulation shall not become binding or effective until fully executed by the Village and PBA, and until it is fully approved and ratified by the Village Board of Trustees.

12. This Stipulation may be executed in more than one counterpart, each of which shall be deemed an original, but all of which shall constitute the same instrument.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, and intending to be legally bound hereby, the Village and PBA have executed the foregoing Stipulation of Agreement.
