# Article XIIB Accessory Dwelling Units

#### 200-100.16

**Legislative Intent:** It is the purpose of this Article to allow accessory apartments in single-family residences in the Village of Ardsley to

- A. Provide opportunity to establish small rental dwelling units as accessory to single-family dwellings in the Village of Ardsley respecting the aesthetics and scale of single-dwelling development and to ensure that any accessory dwelling unit meets applicable building, fire and safety standards;
- B. Ensure that accessory dwelling units do not contribute to or aggravate traffic congestion and parking problems;
- C. Establish small rental dwelling units without increasing building density by utilizing residential and accessory building resources as a means to meet the housing needs of the Village population which may be under-served, especially single persons and couples of all ages with low and moderate incomes, and relatives of existing residents of Ardsley;
- D. Provide economic support for individual residential owners and families, particularly homeowners who would benefit from rental income and those of moderate means, for whom there are limited housing options should they desire to move elsewhere and remain in the Village;
- E. Encourage diversity in the housing stock and the residential population of Ardsley;
- F. Provide accessible housing for seniors and persons with disabilities;
- G. Promote the health, safety and welfare of the residents of the Village of Ardsley and preserve property values;
- H. Provide housing that responds to changing family needs, smaller households, and increasing housing costs.

**200-100.17 Definitions.** The following terms, as used in this article, shall have the following meaning

- A. Accessory Dwelling Unit An accessory dwelling unit (ADU) is a dwelling unit which is incidental and subordinate to a permitted principal one family residence use, and is located on the same lot therewith. ADUs are independently habitable and provide the basic requirements of shelter, heating, cooking, and sanitation.
- B. Accessory Apartment An ADU that is attached to or part of the primary dwelling. Examples include converted living space, attached garages, basements or attics; additions; or a combination thereof.
- C. Accessory Cottage An ADU that is located in an accessory building. Examples include converted detached garages or new construction.

#### 200-100.18 Eligibility.

An ADU may be added on any lot in the R-1, R-2 and R-3 Zoning Districts on which there is a one family dwelling that that meets the requirements of this chapter.

#### 200-100.19 Number of accessory dwelling units per lot.

One ADU is permitted per lot in the R-1, R-2 and R-3 Zoning Districts.

#### 200-100.20 Owner occupancy required.

A lot or parcel of land containing an ADU shall be occupied by the owner of the premises, and the owner must live in either the primary dwelling unit or the ADU. Furthermore, the owner of the one-family lot upon which an ADU is proposed shall have owned and occupied the principle dwelling unit on the property for a minimum of two years immediately preceding the creation of the ADU.

#### 200-100.21 Location on the lot.

- A. An ADU may be created through new construction, conversion of an existing structure, addition to an existing structure, or conversion of a qualifying existing accessory building to an accessory cottage.
- B. An ADU may be located in the principal dwelling building or accessory building provided that such principal dwelling building or accessory building conforms to the other requirements of this chapter, unless a variance therefor shall have been granted by the Zoning Board of Appeals.
- C. An ADU shall not be located in space originally designed to be used for the indoor storage of vehicles, unless such space is in excess of that which is needed to satisfy the minimum off-street parking requirement for the existing principal use on the subject property or unless an alternative on-site location for such parking is provided. Such alternative location may include but shall not be limited to newly constructed garage space or an outdoor parking area located entirely on the property.

#### 200-100.22 Density.

ADUs must comply with all of the applicable residential density standards and zoning regulations of this code.

#### 200-100.23 Floor Area.

The floor area for an ADU shall be at least 300 square feet, but in no case shall it exceed the lesser of 800 square feet or 30% of the total area of the principle dwelling building on the lot. There shall be no more than two bedrooms in any ADU.

#### 200-100.24 Exterior appearance.

No exterior changes shall be made to the building in which the ADU is located that, in the opinion of the Board of Architectural Review, would alter the single-family character and appearance of the property.

#### 200-100.25 Parking Requirements

In addition to the parking requirements for the principal dwelling and other permitted uses, one accessible and usable off-street parking space shall be provided for each ADU.

#### 200-100.26 Water and sewer service

Approval of the proposed method and adequacy of water supply and sewage disposal shall be obtained from the Westchester County Health Department, if required, and shall be further subject to approval by the Planning Board and Building Inspector.

#### 200-100.27 General Regulations

A. The proposed accessory apartment shall be in compliance with all applicable federal, state and local zoning, building, fire, electrical, health and safety codes.

- B. The proposed accessory apartment shall not adversely affect the single-family character of the neighborhood.
- C. The ADU may not be listed for short term rental and the minimum rental or lease period shall not be less than 180 days nor more than 3 calendar years.
- D. There shall be a maximum of 50 ADUs in the Village.

#### 200-100.28 Application Procedure:

- A. A permit for an ADU is to be obtained from the Building Department
- B. A permit for an ADU may be issued only to the owner-occupant of the principal residence at which the accessory apartment is to be located, and said owner must have owned and occupied the principle residence for the two year immediately preceding the application.
- C. An applicant for an ADU permit shall furnish a completed building permit application, a site plan indicating existing and proposed building and lot conditions, floor plans of the principal or accessory building and the proposed accessory apartment and elevation drawings of the principal or accessory building.
- D. The site plan shall also include a location map showing the applicant's property and adjacent property and streets, location of existing and proposed off-street parking, the location of all existing and proposed water and sewer lines, storm water management structures and ingress and egress to/from the site.
- E. Planning Board Site Plan Approval shall be required for any ADUs that are proposed to be located in a newly constructed principle or accessory building.
- F. An application to add and ADU to a property shall not be considered and a permit shall not be issued for any property on which a code violation exists.

#### 200-100.29 Fees:

Application and permits fees for ADUs shall be the same as the fees for building construction as enumerated in §A210-3 of this code.

#### **200-100.30 EFFECTIVE DATE:**

This local law shall take effect immediately upon filing in the office of the New York State Secretary of State in accordance with section 27 of the Municipal Home Rule Law.

**CONTINUATION OF PUBLIC HEARING** To Discuss Amending Chapter 200 Entitled "Zoning" to add Provision for Accessory Dwelling Units of the Ardsley Village Code

Mayor Kaboolian opened the Public Hearing at 8:14 p.m. in the matter amending Chapter 200 Entitled "Zoning" to add Provision for Accessory Dwelling Units of the Ardsley Village Code

1. The following email was received by Mr. Rappaport Ardsley resident:

Dear Mayor:

I have read Dr. Kowalsky's comments regarding ADUS and I agree with him. Further, the restrictions opposed by the County should remain in place if you are going forward with this proposal. We live here - not County bureaucrats. Owner occupancy is essential if properties are to be maintained. I am against any effort to sub-divide a single family lot. The small ADU of today is a potential slippery slope to the mega-ADU of the future.

Frankly, I see a number of other problems outside of the undesirable densification in established single family neighborhoods. I spoke with the Board a while back about a commercial vehicle being improperly parked in a driveway. Because we do not have a code officer on duty on weekends or nights, the problem was never resolved. ADUs will require further monitoring. Efforts to hire additional code enforcement personnel were rejected by the Board. Until that happens, this proposal should be tabled.

I note that Hastings has passed ADU legislation. Let's wait and see what the results are before we rush into this. I am also concerned that if ADUs are allowed,

additional trees may be removed to make room for them. The Ardsley schools are also experiencing unprecedented growth. ADUs may add to that. Having watched Board meetings for 20 years, I have seen the calls to ASVAC also increase year to year. Along these lines, the Atria can be seen as a form of Village ADU. One third of the ASVAC calls are now due to the Atria.

There have been additional concerns expressed in my review of the literature on ADUS that older homes will be torn down so as to permit ADUs.

While no one disputes the need for affordable housing, as Mr. Kowalsky noted, the place for this is in the downtown area as the Comp Plan envisioned. One might add our existing OLD infrastructure is being challenged everyday by climate change and every type of commercial vehicle on our roads (I plead guilty with several Amazon and UPS deliveries everyday) plus using the WONDER truck for meals on occasion.

As Dr. Kowlalsky stated, this legislation appears to be a solution in search of a problem but one that may cause more problems than it solves.

Mayor Kaboolian feels that the ADU legislation is necessary. Mayor Kaboolian reviewed Mr. Williams' & Mr. Rappaport's comments and has looked at the legislation and compared it to Dobbs Ferry and Tarrytown. Our existing proposed law is similar to some of our neighboring communities and believes that there should be some restrictions on size and the number of ADU's and feels there should be restrictions with off street parking. Parking on the street could create congestion. We should amend our proposed legislation to take out the requirement that the owner live in the primary dwelling and we can reduce the occupancy requirement from 2 years to 1 year and reduce the lease term to 6 months. Mayor Kaboolian suggested that we ask for a variance for parking or apply for a parking space.

Trustee DiJusto would like to discuss the square footage of the ADU and we are limited to a 2 bedroom. Would not like to see the ADU as a 2 bedroom. Does not agree with square footage. Parking needs to be looked at on an individual basis and possibly apply for a variance.

Trustee Bencosme agrees with Trustee Di Justo's concerns about parking. She would be interested in lowering the owner occupancy to one and she agrees with looking at reducing the lease term to 6 months.

Trustee Edelstein stated that one of the primary changes is allowing the owner to occupy the residence. Supports the reduction of owner occupancy and lease terms and parking variances which could provide more flexibility.

Mayor Kaboolian recommended that based on the comments and recommendations regarding the ADU, the Board would like to see a re-draft of the legislation/local law and would like to continue the public hearing to the next meeting, December 19th, 2022.

In summary these are the suggested changes:

- Parking issues/possible variance procedure
- Eliminating the owner requirement occupy the primary dwelling
- Reduce the owner occupancy from 2 years to 1 year.
- Reduce the lease term from 1 year to 6 months

Mr. Ben Williams Danforth resident spoke in favor of the ADU law. Mr. Williams stated that there is very little rental inventory in Ardsley.

1.a Village Attorney, Robert J. Ponzini stated he had nothing to report other than those items that may have been submitted in memorandum form and would be available for Executive Session after the meeting if needed.

#### 2. MANAGER

- 2.a Village Manager, Joseph Cerretani read the following manager's report:
  - 1. CAMERA WORK ON SANITARY SEWER LINES: Since last month, Fred Cook has been conducting the CCTV inspections of the sanitary sewer lines. As discussed, we have them starting on roadways that are planned on being paved by ConEdison after the completion of the gas main replacement project in the neighborhoods on the south side of Ashford Avenue. The scope of this phase of the project is expected to last about two months, so they should be complete by the end of January. Staff will work with consultants to determine and address issues identified in the study. What we are seeing so far is thankfully not requiring any substantial repair work. A few small items have been identified, such as some roots coming in through seams, but what has been identified can be resolved without disruption to the roadway. As the project continues, we will be developing a capital improvement schedule to address any issues that are discovered.
  - 2. <u>CURBING:</u> Curbing work is continuing this week as we approach the winter season, but we anticipate this phase of the project to be wrapping up by the end of next week, as the asphalt plants have given notice of closing shortly. The goal is for the contractor to finish the north side of Lincoln Avenue in its entirety. The south side of Lincoln, along with Euclid Avenue will be completed in spring.
  - 3. **DPW GARAGE:** The project is continuing to move along nicely. We are hoping to have the footings in by the end of the year, and we are working closely with the Town of Greenburgh for the installation of the new water main that will be servicing the property. Contractors will continue to work through the season, as weather conditions and supplies allow.
  - 4. **PEDESTRIAN SAFETY/CROSSING GUARDS:** On Friday, Dec. 2, David DiGregorio, Chief Piccolino and I met with Dr. Schoenfeld and Joe Urbanowicz from the school district to discuss speed control devices along Francis McCormack Drive going to the middle school. The meeting was very productive and we have come up with some ideas in mind that we think will greatly benefit pedestrian safety. We will discuss these ideas with our

consultant engineer and have the project designed to meet all required specifications. It is anticipated that the projects being discussed can be completed using in-house resources, but we will confirm that after the design stage. We are also advertising for a second crossing guard position to assist with pedestrian safety. We are hoping to have the new hire start at the beginning of the year. Details about the position can be found on our website <a href="https://www.ardsleyvillage.com">www.ardsleyvillage.com</a> and anyone interested in the position should contact Chief Piccolino at (914) 693-1700. Chief Piccolino and I have also internally discussed options to enhance pedestrian safety around schools including looking into radar signs and additional enforcement and should have more to report in the upcoming weeks. In the meantime, the Chief has engaged the Town of Greenburgh to borrow one of their speed indicator signs and it will be placed on Heatherdell Avenue. We will closely monitor the success of that pilot program and if it is impactful, we can look into pricing options to procure one of our own.

5. VILLAGE TAXES: The second installment of the Village tax bill became due and payable on December 1st, 2022 and can be paid without penalty until 4:00 pm on Tuesday, January 3, 2023. Payments arriving via mail postmarked by the USPS after January 3, 2023, or arrive after January 3, 2023 without a postmark, will be assessed a late penalty as required by New York State Real Property law. Meter-mailed postmarks are not valid proof of timely payment. No Village official is empowered to waive the late fee for any reason. Residents are asked not to bring their tax payment in on Saturday, December 31, 2022 since our offices will be closed.


#### Community information

# CDC streamlines COVID-19 guidance to help the public better protect themselves and understand their risk

Today, CDC is streamlining its COVID-19 guidance to help people better understand their risk, how to protect themselves and others, what actions to take if exposed to COVID-19, and what actions to take if they are sick or test positive for the virus. COVID-19 continues to circulate globally, however, with so many tools available to us for reducing COVID-19 severity, there is significantly less risk of severe illness, hospitalization and death compared to earlier in the pandemic.

"We're in a stronger place today as a nation, with more tools—like vaccination, boosters, and treatments—to protect ourselves, and our communities, from severe illness from COVID-19," said Greta Massetti, PhD, MPH, MMWR author. "We also have a better understanding of how to protect people from being exposed to the virus, like wearing high-quality masks, testing, and improved ventilation. This guidance acknowledges that the pandemic is not over, but also helps us move to a point where COVID-19 no longer severely disrupts our daily lives." In support of this update CDC is:

• Continuing to promote the importance of being <u>up to date with vaccination</u> to protect people against serious illness, hospitalization, and death. Protection provided by the current vaccine against symptomatic infection and transmission is less than that against severe disease and diminishes over time, especially against the currently circulating

variants. For this reason, it is important to stay up to date, especially as new vaccines become available.

- Updating its guidance for people who are not up to date on COVID-19 vaccines on what to do if exposed to someone with COVID-19. This is consistent with the existing guidance for people who are up to date on COVID-19 vaccines.
- Recommending that instead of quarantining if you were exposed to COVID-19, you
  wear a high-quality mask for 10 days and get tested on day 5.
- Reiterating that regardless of vaccination status, you should isolate from others when you have COVID-19.
  - You should also isolate if you are sick and suspect that you have COVID-19 but do not yet have test results.
    - If your results are positive, follow CDC's full isolation recommendations.
    - If your results are negative, you can end your isolation.
- Recommending that if you test positive for COVID-19, you stay home for at least 5 days and isolate from others in your home. You are likely most infectious during these first 5 days. Wear a high-quality mask when you must be around others at home and in public.
  - o If after 5 days you are fever-free for 24 hours without the use of medication, and your symptoms are improving, or you never had symptoms, you may end isolation after day 5.
  - Regardless of when you end isolation, avoid being around people who are more likely to get very sick from COVID-19 until at least day 11.
  - o You should wear a high-quality mask through day 10.
- Recommending that if you had <u>moderate illness</u> (if you experienced shortness of breath or had difficulty breathing) or <u>severe illness</u> (you were hospitalized) due to COVID-19 or you have a weakened immune system, you need to isolate through day 10.
- Recommending that if you had <u>severe illness</u> or have a weakened immune system, consult your doctor before ending isolation. Ending isolation without a viral test may not be an option for you. If you are unsure if your symptoms are moderate or severe or if you have a weakened immune system, talk to a healthcare provider for further guidance.
- Clarifying that after you have ended isolation, if your COVID-19 symptoms worsen, restart your isolation at day 0. Talk to a healthcare provider if you have questions about your symptoms or when to end isolation.
- Recommending screening testing of asymptomatic people without known exposures will no longer be recommended in most community settings.

• Emphasizing that physical distance is just one component of how to protect yourself and others. It is important to consider the risk in a particular setting, including local COVID-19 Community Levels and the important role of ventilation, when assessing the need to maintain physical distance.

Actions to take will continue to be informed by the <u>COVID-19 Community Levels</u>, launched in February. CDC will continue to focus efforts on preventing severe illness and post-COVID conditions, while ensuring everyone have the information and tools, they need to lower their risk.

This updated guidance is intended to apply to community settings. In the coming weeks CDC will work to align stand-alone guidance documents, such as those for healthcare settings, congregate settings at higher risk of transmission, and travel, with today's update.



# RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES DECLARING A NEGATIVE DECLARATION OF NO ENVIRONMENTAL IMPACT RELATED TO PROPOSED ZONING TEXT AMENDMENTS TO ALLOW ACCESSORY DWELLING UNITS IN SINGLE FAMILY RESIDENCES AND ADOPTION OF PROPOSED AMENDMENTS

WHEREAS, in February 2021, the Village of Ardsley Board of Trustees (the Village Board) adopted a duly prepared Comprehensive Plan and Local Waterfront Revitalization Program (LWRP) which included significant public input including public hearings and an environmental review as required by the New York State Environmental Quality Review (SEQR); and

**WHEREAS**, the Comprehensive Plan outlined certain goals and objectives related to diversifying the current housing stock, enhancing additional opportunities for housing, and increasing housing availability and affordability; and

WHEREAS, Section 200-13 of the Code of the Village of Ardsley provides for the process and procedures for amendments to the Village's Zoning Code, and accordingly a draft of proposed zoning text amendments to allow accessory dwelling units (ADU) in single family residences (the Proposed Action) has been prepared for Village Board review; and

**WHEREAS,** on March 9, 2022, September 14, 2022 and on October 17, 2022, at regularly scheduled meetings of the Village Board, the Board did review and discuss the proposed zoning revisions; and


**WHEREAS,** the Village Board, under Section 7-700 of New York State Village Law and Section 200-13 of the Code of the Village of Ardsley, is the only duly authorized legislative body that has the authority to approve the Proposed Action; and

WHEREAS, on October 19, 2022, the Village Board, given its exclusive authority to amend the zoning code did declare itself to be the Lead Agency under SEQR for the review and environmental determination for the Proposed Action and did circulate the proposed zoning text to a comprehensive list of other Interested Agencies along with a notice of public hearing for November 21, 2022; and,

**WHEREAS,** the Village received comments on the Proposed Action from Westchester County Department of Planning dated October 21, 2022; and

**WHEREAS,** on November 21, 2022, the Village Board opened a duly noticed public hearing in which all members of the public were invited to participate and the public hearing was subsequently closed on December 19, 2022; and

NOW THEREFOR BE IT RESOLVED, that after review of the entire record, consideration of public input including other Interested Agencies, input from staff and consultants serving the Village and the information outlined in the environmental assessment form, Parts 1, 2, and 3 does hereby declare that the Proposed Action will not have a significant adverse impact on the environment and issues a Negative Declaration under SEQR; and be it further



## Article XIIB Accessory Dwelling Units

#### 200-100.16

**Legislative Intent:** It is the purpose of this Article to allow accessory apartments in single-family residences in the Village of Ardsley to

- A. Provide opportunity to establish small rental dwelling units as accessory to single-family dwellings in the Village of Ardsley respecting the aesthetics and scale of single-dwelling development and to ensure that any accessory dwelling unit meets applicable building, fire and safety standards;
- B. Ensure that accessory dwelling units do not contribute to or aggravate traffic congestion and parking problems;
- C. Establish small rental dwelling units without increasing building density by utilizing residential and accessory building resources as a means to meet the housing needs of the Village population which may be under-served, especially single persons and couples of all ages with low and moderate incomes, and relatives of existing residents of Ardsley;
- D. Provide economic support for individual residential owners and families, particularly homeowners who would benefit from rental income and those of moderate means, for whom there are limited housing options should they desire to move elsewhere and remain in the Village;
- E. Encourage diversity in the housing stock and the residential population of Ardsley;
- F. Provide accessible housing for seniors and persons with disabilities;
- G. Promote the health, safety and welfare of the residents of the Village of Ardsley and preserve property values;
- H. Provide housing that responds to changing family needs, smaller households, and increasing housing costs.

**200-100.17 Definitions.** The following terms, as used in this article, shall have the following meaning

- A. Accessory Dwelling Unit An accessory dwelling unit (ADU) is a dwelling unit which is incidental and subordinate to a permitted principal one family residence use, and is located on the same lot therewith. ADUs are independently habitable and provide the basic requirements of shelter, heating, cooking, and sanitation.
- B. Accessory Apartment An ADU that is attached to or part of the primary dwelling. Examples include converted living space, attached garages, basements or attics; additions; or a combination thereof.
- C. Accessory Cottage An ADU that is located in an accessory building. Examples include converted detached garages or new construction.

#### 200-100.18 Eligibility.

An ADU may be added on any lot in the R-1, R-2 and R-3 Zoning Districts on which there is a one family dwelling that that meets the requirements of this chapter.

#### 200-100.19 Number of accessory dwelling units per lot.

One ADU is permitted per lot in the R-1, R-2 and R-3 Zoning Districts.

#### 200-100.20 Owner occupancy required.

A lot or parcel of land containing an ADU shall be occupied by the owner of the premises, and the owner must live in either the primary dwelling unit or the ADU. Furthermore, the owner of the one-family lot upon which an ADU is proposed shall have owned and occupied the principle dwelling unit on the property for a minimum of two years immediately preceding the creation of the ADU.

#### 200-100.21 Location on the lot.

- A. An ADU may be created through new construction, conversion of an existing structure, addition to an existing structure, or conversion of a qualifying existing accessory building to an accessory cottage.
- B. An ADU may be located in the principal dwelling building or accessory building provided that such principal dwelling building or accessory building conforms to the other requirements of this chapter, unless a variance therefor shall have been granted by the Zoning Board of Appeals.
- C. An ADU shall not be located in space originally designed to be used for the indoor storage of vehicles, unless such space is in excess of that which is needed to satisfy the minimum off-street parking requirement for the existing principal use on the subject property or unless an alternative on-site location for such parking is provided. Such alternative location may include but shall not be limited to newly constructed garage space or an outdoor parking area located entirely on the property.

#### 200-100.22 Density.

ADUs must comply with all of the applicable residential density standards and zoning regulations of this code.

#### 200-100.23 Floor Area.

The floor area for an ADU shall be at least 300 square feet, but in no case shall it exceed the lesser of 800 square feet or 30% of the total area of the principle dwelling building on the lot. There shall be no more than two bedrooms in any ADU.

#### 200-100.24 Exterior appearance.

No exterior changes shall be made to the building in which the ADU is located that, in the opinion of the Board of Architectural Review, would alter the single-family character and appearance of the property.

#### 200-100.25 Parking Requirements

In addition to the parking requirements for the principal dwelling and other permitted uses, one accessible and usable off-street parking space shall be provided for each ADU.

#### 200-100.26 Water and sewer service

Approval of the proposed method and adequacy of water supply and sewage disposal shall be obtained from the Westchester County Health Department, if required, and shall be further subject to approval by the Planning Board and Building Inspector.

#### 200-100.27 General Regulations

A. The proposed accessory apartment shall be in compliance with all applicable federal, state and local zoning, building, fire, electrical, health and safety codes.

- B. The proposed accessory apartment shall not adversely affect the single-family character of the neighborhood.
- C. The ADU may not be listed for short term rental and the minimum rental or lease period shall not be less than 180 days nor more than 3 calendar years.
- D. There shall be a maximum of 50 ADUs in the Village.

#### 200-100.28 Application Procedure:

- A. A permit for an ADU is to be obtained from the Building Department
- B. A permit for an ADU may be issued only to the owner-occupant of the principal residence at which the accessory apartment is to be located, and said owner must have owned and occupied the principle residence for the two year immediately preceding the application.
- C. An applicant for an ADU permit shall furnish a completed building permit application, a site plan indicating existing and proposed building and lot conditions, floor plans of the principal or accessory building and the proposed accessory apartment and elevation drawings of the principal or accessory building.
- D. The site plan shall also include a location map showing the applicant's property and adjacent property and streets, location of existing and proposed off-street parking, the location of all existing and proposed water and sewer lines, storm water management structures and ingress and egress to/from the site.
- E. Planning Board Site Plan Approval shall be required for any ADUs that are proposed to be located in a newly constructed principle or accessory building.
- F. An application to add and ADU to a property shall not be considered and a permit shall not be issued for any property on which a code violation exists.

#### 200-100.29 Fees:

Application and permits fees for ADUs shall be the same as the fees for building construction as enumerated in §A210-3 of this code.

#### **200-100.30 EFFECTIVE DATE:**

This local law shall take effect immediately upon filing in the office of the New York State Secretary of State in accordance with section 27 of the Municipal Home Rule Law.

Dear Sirs:

I am pleased to provide you with Legal Services normally provided as Village Attorney on a contractual basis for the period of 01/01/23 through 12/31/2023 with annual compensation of \$73,545. This retainer will be automatically adjusted in an amount equivalent to the annual percentage increase in compensation for Ardsley nonunion employees. What follows is my standard retainer letter, including the terms and conditions of my understanding with you.

Legal Service: As your contractual attorney, I will provide the services normally provided by an appointed Village Attorney, as more generally defined by custom and practice in the most recent past. Included but not limited are the following examples of the legal services that will be provided: Attendance at all regularly scheduled Village Board meetings; Attendance as needed at all Village executive sessions, work sessions, Zoning Board Meetings, Planning Board Meetings, consultation with all Department Heads, including but not limited to, the Village Manager, Village Clerk, Building Inspector, Village Treasurer or any other Department Head or employee requested by the Village Manager. Services also include the drafting of local legislation, preparing memorandum for review by the Mayor, Board and Village Manager, providing legal advice and legal opinions, and reviewing all basic legal documents and contracts required in the normal course of Village business. This list of services is not all encompassing and will be adjusted from time to time as circumstance might require.

1. With respect to these services, you will be billed on a monthly basis in twelve equal installments on the first of the month computed from the annual contract amount to be determined by the Mayor and Board of Trustees for basic legal services as shall be hereafter defined. If there are special projects that exceed the parameters of the basic services of Village Attorney, to be determined upon discussion with the Village Manager, or if there is litigation not compensated by insurance, the Village will be billed on a separate hourly basis. The hourly billing rates shall be

\$200.00 for attorneys and \$100.00 for paralegals. These hourly rates are subject to potential increase over time subject to your approval. You further understand that the hourly rates apply to all time expended relative to your matter, including but not limited to, office meetings and conferences; telephone calls and conferences, either placed by or placed to you, or otherwise made or had on your behalf or related to your matter; preparation, review and revision of correspondence, or any legal research, preparation of correspondence and memoranda, hearing appearances; client or multi-party conferences; file review; preparation time, travel time, time spent in meeting with or conferencing with counsel; and any other time expended on behalf of or in connection with your matter, including drafting of a final report and recommendation. Hourly billing shall be in minimum increments of 0.1 hours. Again, these hourly rates and billings only apply to special projects or litigation not compensated by insurance.

- 2. In addition to the above legal fees with respect to special projects and uncompensated litigation, you will also be responsible for reimbursing us for our out of pocket expenses and disbursements including, but not limited to, transcript fees, messenger service, postage, overnight deliveries, and printing and copying (at \$0.25/page, or the actual cost if sent to an outside vendor) where required, as well as all other expenses incurred in connection with the proper representation of you in the above proceedings. Every effort will be employed to minimize out of pocket expenses and if a significant disbursement is anticipated, it will be discussed in advance with the Village Manager and incurred only with approval
- 3. Bills for services and disbursements will be rendered on a monthly basis. If the invoices for our services and/or disbursement are not paid within ninety (90) days, we reserve the right to decline to perform further services until paid in full and/or to terminate the retainer and withdraw completely from representing you
- 4. In the event that a dispute or disagreement arises between us relating to our fees, you may have the right to arbitration of the dispute pursuant to Part 137 of the Rules of Chief Administrator of the Courts, a copy of which will be provided to you upon request. If you discharge us, or we complete this matter, and there is money left over in escrow after paying our final time and expense invoice, you shall be entitled to a refund of any unused retainer.
- 5. This retainer agreement shall be governed by the laws of the State of New York, and you hereby consent and acknowledge that you will be subject to the jurisdiction of the Courts of New York and shall and hereby do waive any objection in connection therewith.

Once our engagement pursuant to this agreement or any litigation or special project ends, we will send you a written notice advising you that this engagement has concluded. You may thereafter direct us to return, retain or discard some or all of the documents pertaining to the engagements, except for those that we are mandated to maintain for a prescribed period of time. If you do not respond to the notice within sixty (60) days, you agree and understand that any materials left with us after the engagement ends may be retained or destroyed at our discretion, except as

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otherwise prohibited by law or rule. Notwithstanding the foregoing, and unless you instruct us otherwise, we will return any documents we know or believe that you will need to retain to enforce your rights or to bring or defend claims. You should understand that materials@ include paper files as well as information in other mediums of storage including voicemail, email (subject to the Firm's email retention policies from time to time), printer files, copier files, facsimiles, dictation recordings, video files, and other formats. We reserve the right to make, at our expense, certain copies of all documents generated or received by us in the course of our representation. When you request copies of documents from us, copies that we generate will be made at your expense. We will maintain the confidentiality of all documents throughout the process. It is the general policy not to retain at any time original Village files. Originals, with the exception of litigation files, will always be maintained at Village Hall to maintain continuity and provide accessibility.
