General Rules:

- Sign up for the SRC starting **June 15, 2023**.
- **KIDS** must come to the Library **ANYTIME BEFORE THURSDAY** and report on the books they've read. There will be no reporting done on Thursdays.
- Fill out one slip per book read, or 1 slip for every 50 pages read. Check with a librarian or teen volunteer before dropping your slips in the raffle box. The more books you read, the better your chances to win in our weekly raffles!
- For every 3 book slips completed, take a guess at the amount of Legos in the jar.

Raffle Rules:

- No more than 3 wins per person per night.
- All raffle slips go into the bin for the Grand Prize raffles on: **August 3rd**
- One grand prize win, and up to 3 Books at Closing Party.

Guess How Many Legos are in the Jar?:

- To earn a guess, you must complete 3 book slips.
- The closest guess to the number of Legos in the container wins it all at our closing party.
