Road work

I know we have had road construction all over the Village for a long time. I understand that it is difficult at times but maintaining our infrastructure is vital. Con Edison is doing a massive gas main replacement job. We are working with Con Ed to keep to a schedule, but Covid-19 precautions and other factors have caused delays. In addition, we are keeping with our Village schedule of new curbing and road resurfacing. Ardsley joins with the other Rivertown Villages in a joint bid for road paving. This keeps costs down for all of us. This year's work will include work on Bramblebrook Road, Exeter Place, Overlook Road, Captain Honeywell East, and the Addyman Square parking lot.

Reassessment

The Town of Greenburgh Assessor's Office is responsible for the assessed valuations to all real property in the Village of Ardsley. Greenburgh is currently doing a reassessment. The Village of Ardsley achieved an 80% response rate. For anyone who has not completed the census the time is now or wait another 10 years to be counted.

Early voting and absentee ballots

New York State launched an online portal where all registered voters can request an **absentee ballot** if you are worried about in-person voting due to COVID.

If you are not registered to vote or need to change your voter registration address.

In addition to voting by absentee ballot, you can **vote early** in-person at your Early Voting polling place from **October 24 to November 1**. Registered voters can cast their ballot at ANY of the 17 designated early voting locations

These locations include: Dobbs Ferry Village Hall, 112 Main Street, Dobbs Ferry, NY 10522; Greenburgh Town Hall, 177 Hillside Avenue, White Plains, NY 10607; and Westchester County Board of Elections, 25 Quarropas Street, White Plains, NY 10601.

You can still vote in-person on Election Day, November 3rd.
