Our Village project improves the quality of the Sprain Brook (1), an important tributary of the Bronx River. Proper treatment of stormwater runoff is necessary to achieve this upgrade. This demonstration project highlights stormwater treatment techniques that may be incorporated in residential as well as commercial locations. Techniques include use of porous pavement, catch basin modification, sustainable gardening practices, rain garden, rain barrel and stream bank restoration.
