

Thirteen people attended the meeting including Mayor Kaboolian, Trustees DiJusto, Edelstein, Weitz and Bencosme, Village Manager Cerretani, Village Attorney Ponzini, Village Clerk Rocco, Executive Secy Hessler, Kapsis/CAC, and Library Trustees Cavallini and Halmo.

Mayor Kaboolian discussed plastic recycling and mentioned that polystyrene spoons are not generally recyclable. She said that the Village is grateful for the Army Corps of Engineers Flood Control Project which began during the administration of Village Manager Idoni. She asked about cleaning out storm drains and L. Kuhn answered that the Sweeper Vac truck has been very busy both sweeping streets and vacuuming out storm drains. There was a question about storm drains. There were 597 storm drains mapped previously, and the new Mapping Project will add to that total and also include sanitary sewers. Mayor noted that disposable masks now appear as frequent litter items. Tr DiJusto talked about tap water chlorination. Tr Bencosme asked about whether storm resiliency could be improved with more green infrastructure. L. Kuhn answered that very big storms like Hurricane Ida overwhelm all stormwater practices, both "green" and "grey" and that all practices need maintenance and cleanup after storms. Mayor Kaboolian asked when we could get the DEC pumpout hose & truck for the Village Green, and L. Kuhn answered that they would come within 24 hours if needed, but other communities had higher priority need for the equipment than Ardsley. Mayor reminded residents to pick up after their pets and not to throw waste into storm drains.

There were no changes to the Stormwater Management Plan required following the Village Board meeting.
